III. Those That Are Untouchable – vs 18, 19

- A. The believer His assurances: vs. 18, 19a
 - 1. Does not practice sin:
 - a. I John 3:6, 9
 - 2. Is not in the control of the Devil touch: "to fasten oneself to"
 - a. I John 3:8
 - 3. Knows he is of God
 - a. I John 5:13

- B. The Believer: His accuser v. 19a
 - 1. His name: the evil one
 - a. Revelation 12:9, 10
 - 2. His power

IV. Those That Have Understanding – v. 20

- A. We know that Christ is the true God vs. 20a, c
 - 1. "We know": to know by experience
 - 2. "The true God": genuine or real
 - a. Titus 2:13, 14
- B. We know that we are in Him. v. 20b
 - 1. I John 5:13
 - 2. II Timothy 1:12

V. Those That Are Unattached – v. 21

- A. Definition:
 - 1. "Guard": "to guard, watch, keep watch"
 - 2. Use of shepherd's: Luke 2:8 and soldiers, Acts 28:16
- B. Application:

(Most of those who received this letter were Gentile converts living in the idolatrous cities of Asia)

- 1. Warning about being attached to the wrong things and people
 - a. Deuteronomy 11:16, 17; 13:17; Joshua 23:6-12
- 2. Admonishments to be attached to the right person and things
 - a. Deuteronomy 10:20; 11:22; Matthew 22:37; Philippians 4:8; Colossians 3:2
- 3. He who is able to keep you
 - a. Jude 24
