- A. What our Doctrinal Statement says
  - 1. Article II, Section 3: "That the Lord Jesus Christ was conceived by the Holy Spirit; born of the virgin Mary and is truly God and truly man."

  - 1. Genesis 3:15; 22:18; 49:10
  - 2. Isaiah 7:14; Jeremiah 23:5, 6
  - 3. Micah 5:2, 3
- C. The story of His coming
  - 1. Gabriel tells Zechariah that Elizabeth will give birth to Jesus' forerunner John the Baptist. Malachi 4:5, 6; Luke 1:11-13
  - 2. Gabriel tells Mary she will bear the Messiah. Luke 1:26-32; Matthew 1:16
  - 3. Mary visits Elizabeth. Luke 1:36-45
  - 4. John the Baptist is born. Luke 1:57-80
  - 5. The Roman census is decreed Luke 2:1-3
  - 6. Joseph and Mary travel to Bethlehem for the census and Jesus is born. Luke 2:4-7
  - 7. An angel announces the birth of Jesus. Luke 2:8-20

- 8. Eight days later, Jesus is circumcised in the temple and recognized as Messiah by Anna and Simeon. Luke 2:21-28
- 9. At least one year later wise men from the east followed His star to Bethlehem and acknowledged Jesus as Messiah. Matthew 2:1-12
- 10. Herod slaughters Bethlehem boys under two and Joseph sneaks his family out of Bethlehem to Egypt as directed in a dream. Matthew 2:13-18
- 11. At least one year later Joseph settles his family in Nazareth. Matthew 2:19-24
